São relacionados 121 títulos de livros, artigos, capítulos de livro e notas relativas a bibliografia ornitológica brasileira, conforme critérios estabelecidos na primeira contribuição desta série (*Ararajuba* 4: 56). Entretanto, deixam de ser agregados, daqui por diante, a maior parte dos títulos produzidos pela atividade nacional de criação de aves em cativeiro, ou seja, artigos de ornitofilia ou aviculturismo. Não serão alvo da pesquisa compilatória também, as matérias ornitológicas, anônimas ou assinadas por jornalistas, veiculadas em jornais ou revistas populares. São mantidos, contudo, aqueles artigos relacionados à divulgação científica escritos por ornitólogos e publicados sob qualquer formato, desde que atendidas as mesmas premissas básicas originais.

Os títulos aqui listados datam principalmente de 1997, secundados de alguns outros publicados no triênio anterior que pretendem suplementar as compilações previamente fornecidas. Foram incluídos antecipadamente cinco títulos publicados no primeiro trimestre de 1998.
